6.i. Zoning Ordinance Text Amendment to Section 11-2-15: Single Family Detached Dwelling Requirements to update the maximum area of attached garages

Mayor Droste pulled this item for further discussion. Community Development Director Lindquist provided an overview of the updated requirements. Staff has reviewed the ordinances of other communities as they relate to the maximum area of attached garages. Based upon staff's findings, staff is recommending an amendment to the zoning ordinance to allow the footprint of attached

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garages to be no more than 50% of the gross floor area of the house (living area and garage combined), up 1,500 square feet. This update would take care of the general requests received.
