UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- a. Parks and Recreation Fees

Motion by DeBettignies Second by Speich

Motion to recommend that the City Council change the parks and recreation fees as listed below:

Indoor Ice: (The Arena fee changes would be put in place starting January 2026)

*Increase hourly PRIME ICE from \$235 to \$255

*Increase hourly NON-PRIME ICE from \$155 to \$175

*Increase hourly SPRING/SUMMER PRIME/NON-PRIME ICE from \$155 to \$175

*Additional language – No school day rentals are charged at the prime rate.

Rosemount Community Center Banquet Hall: Add \$150 for Sunday – Thursday rentals scheduled past 10:00 p.m., no later than midnight.

Steeple Center: Increase the Saturday (all day) rentals from Res. \$700 to \$840 and non-residents from \$980 to \$1120.
