

**ROSEMOUNT CITY COUNCIL
WORK SESSION PROCEEDINGS
FEBRUARY 4, 2025**

CALL TO ORDER

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a work session meeting of the Rosemount City Council was held on Tuesday, February 4, 2025, at 5:30 PM. in Rosemount Council Chambers, 2875 145th Street West.

Mayor Weisensel called the meeting to order with Councilmembers Freske, Essler and Klimpel. Councilmember Theisen was absent.

UPDATES

a. Staff Reports

Parks and Recreation Department

Parks and Recreation Director Schultz informed City Council on staff using an affidavit form for projects that will show responsibility for when an inspection is missed. This form would be used in the field and would need to be signed by the owner.

Mr. Schultz noted the property adjacent to McMenomy Woods has a minimum bid of \$8,000 at an upcoming Dakota County Auction. Staff is interested in purchasing the property as it will allow for trail access to the north.

Staff is developing a landscape plan in the near future for the dog park project that is next to the pickle ball courts. Then, the project will go out for bid. The project should be done in early spring.

Administrative Services Department

Staff discussed the current open seats for City Commissions, noting the Environmental and Sustainable Commission (ESC) is down to two members. Staff proposed combining the ESC and Parks & Recreation Commission being there is a lot of cross-over in the two commissions goals and work plans. City Council is in favor with the combining of the two commissions.

City Clerk Fasbender discussed a request that was received to amend our current city code to allow for licensed massage therapist to massage at other locations rather than just one permanent location. City Council members were not interested in changing the city code at this time.

Council Updates

Council member Essler provided updates regarding MVTA, noting Dakota County is not represented

currently.

Staff provided updates on The Clover and Super America, noting there will be further updates in the future.

There being no further business to come before the City Council at the regular council meeting and upon a motion by Weisensel the meeting was adjourned at 6:34 p.m.
