a. Guest Speakers: Dan Schultz & Greg Lund; Parks & Recreation

Parks and Recreation Director Dan Schultz began by describing his role with the City, noting that recreation initiatives are a major priority for the City Council—a benefit that helps keep our community looking its best. He also shared several park projects currently under consideration, including a new athletic complex, two additional ice sheets, and expanded pickleball facilities.

Parks Supervisor Greg Lund then led a hands-on activity in which the Commissioners voted on which proposed playground design they felt was the best fit for Bloomfield Park. After the votes were cast, Mr. Lund and Mr. Schultz facilitated a group discussion about the Commissioners' preferences, highlighting what they liked and disliked about each option.

Deputy Clerk Saunders posed five thought-provoking leadership questions to the group. Each Commissioner responded to the questions they felt comfortable answering, sparking a conversation that encouraged self-awareness and shifted their focus from accomplishments to relationships and the emotional impact they have on their peers.
